MINOR IN ASIAN AMERICAN STUDIES

Completion of the minor requires students to complete fifteen (15) credits at the 2000-level and above by completion of Groups A, B, and C, below; but with consent of the minor advisor, one course from Group D* may be substituted for a course in Group C. No other substitutions are permitted.

Students must earn a grade of C or better in each of the courses applied to the minor.

A maximum of three (3) credits towards the minor may be transfer credits of courses equivalent to University of Connecticut courses.
